The Europe Working Group of ETHsustainability, was founded as the Centre for Sustainability at ETH Zurich, a university with an international reputation.

ETH sustainability sees sustainability as a holistic, economic, ecological and social concept with a strong tie to implementation and transformational knowledge. New forms of multi- and trans-disciplinary research and practical, sustainable solutions clearly need to be found and the centre acts as an open forum and service centre with an experimental character in the areas of dialogue, services and education. It aims to promote and support economically sustainable communities and social and cultural structures without impairing the opportunities of future generations.

ETHsustainability activities consist of dialogue platforms, services, education and teaching. In an industrial and service-oriented society, the centre is an open forum and catalyst in all areas of sustainable development.

The [World YES Forum](#) is a project currently being undertaken by ETHsustainability, having come about as the result of five successful years running the Youth Encounter on Sustainability (YES). The principal goals of the WYF are:

- the creation of an international centre for sustainability education at ETH Zurich with regional satellite centres to foster leadership for sound future development
- the creation and strengthening of a global network of sustainability leaders through expansion of the YES alumni network

The project focuses on three different themes:

1. Regional perspectives towards sustainable development ("Beyond Agenda 21")
2. Sustainability Leadership (SLS)
3. Corporate Social Responsibility and Climate Change (CSR and CC)

There are 4 different forums with subgroups which will have an assigned Forum Leader (FL) who will be responsible for leading discussions. All FLs will be in regular contact with the RPM Europe.
